

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS - Participants

### Event : Insurance Innovation Hackathon 2022

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### Q1. What are the Hackathon Challenges?

Our Insurance Innovation Hackathon 2022 consists of two (2) tracks:

#### a) Capture the Flag (CTF) Challenge

Capture the Flag ("CTF") - A competition where the Participants are required to find specific "flag IDs" that are planted within system vulnerabilities. Participants are required to submit the flag ID via the Programme page on FortNynja's platform.

#### b) Build Your Minimum Viable Product (MVP)

Build Minimum Viable Product ("MVP") - A competition where the Participants select a Problem Statement (which will be provided by the Organisers), brainstorm and submit a working prototype (MVP) or solution that addresses the selected Problem Statement.

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The judging criteria for both CTF and Build your MVP can be found in the Participants' Toolkit which will be made available during Pre Hackathon bootcamp on 31 March 2022.

#### **Q2. Is this an individual or team-based Hackathon?**

It will be a team-based Hackathon (max six (6) individuals per team). However, you can choose to go solo by registering only yourself in a team.

All participants will be required to include their email, which will be used to create their account on FortNynja's Platform.

#### **Q3. How do I register for the Hackathon?**

#### **Q4. I do not have a team but would like to join forces with others. How do I do that?**

Complete your registration on The Malaysian Insurance Institute's website. You will have the opportunity to meet and network with other Participants during Pre Hackathon day (31 March 2022), where you will be able to form / join a team.

#### **Q5. Do I need to pay to register for the Hackathon?**

Yes, the registration fee ranges between RM10-45 per individual, with the option of a limited edition T-shirt (inclusive of shipping). All fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

#### **Q6. What are the criterias to qualify as a Participant in the Hackathon?**

- a. Open to all working professionals, fresh graduates, and university students.
- b. Open to all individuals aged 18 (as of 31 March 2022) and above.
- c. Open to all Malaysian citizens and non-Malaysians with valid Malaysian PR or work/student permit.
- d. Applicants must be physically in Malaysia.
- e. Each applicant should have an information technology (IT) or programming related background in order to complete the given challenge (only applicable for the CTF challenge).
- f. All individuals (whether participating in a team or not) must complete the registration form on The Malaysian Insurance Institute's website and the



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eKYC process on the FortNynja's Platform to be considered as a successful participant.

#### **Q7. Do I need to have any specific qualifications to join the Hackathon?**

If you love to:

- code; or
- have a background in information technology (IT) or programming; or
- design/create interesting and innovative ideas to solve the problem statements,

You are more than welcome to participate in the Hackathon.

We encourage you to build a team of diverse skill sets to increase your chance of winning the cash prizes and award titles. For the CTF challenge, you will require basic coding and cybersecurity skill sets to try and crack the CTF Challenge.

#### **Q8. I have registered on the MII website, what's next?**

- i. A confirmation email of successful registration will be directly sent to your registered email address. Please check spam/junk.
- ii. On Pre Hackathon Day (31 March 2022), an onboarding email along with other essentials will be sent to your registered email address. Please check spam/junk.
- iii. Follow the instructions to validate your identity (eKYC) and set up your Discord account which will be emailed to you. You should have on hand an official valid identification of yourself (e.g., NRIC, passport, etc).

#### **Q9. What is Discord? Where can I find more information about it?**

Discord is the primary communication channel for all parties (ie., Participants, Organiser, Judges, Mentors, etc). Further details will be provided within the Toolkit.

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#### **Q10. If one of my team members fails the eKYC, will the rest of the team be disqualified?**

Failing the eKYC will limit the Participant's access to the platform. Users without passing the eKYC will not be eligible to access the Programmes and submit their idea/solution.

#### **Q11. Where can I find the Problem Statements (for the MVP challenge)?**

The problem statements will be/are released on several key dates - 26 January 2022, 23 February 2022, and 23 March 2022 during the workshops.

#### **Q12. How do I submit my solution or working prototype (MVP) for the Hackathon?**

All submissions have to be made on FortNynja's platform. The link and the toolkit will be provided to you during the Pre Hackathon event (31 March 2022).

#### **Q13. Do I need to have the entire idea fully working / implemented?**

This is not necessary, especially for the Build My MVP challenge. It is up to the participants to build up the solutions according to the judging criteria to win the challenge. Participants will only be allowed to use publicly available resources and/or those that offer free trials (paid APIs are **NOT** allowed).

#### **Q14. Does the FortNynja's Platform support any language?**

The platform for the Hackathon will be conducted in English during the competition/ pitch / mentoring and report submission.

#### **Q15. Do you provide any tools to work on the problems?**

No, Participants can use any public, open source tools for this Hackathon. Please refer to Q17 **"Since there is no specific technology mentioned, are there any restrictions using pre-built libraries?"**

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#### **Q16. Do I have to be online and available for the entire duration of the Hackathon?**

You may not need to be online / available throughout the Hackathon. However, should there be any specific sessions scheduled such as mentoring sessions/ pitching sessions and for any announcements made on the Discord Server, all participants are required to be online.

FortNynja will not be held responsible if any participants were to miss out on any information and/or scheduled sessions which are communicated/announced prior in the Discord server, which may affect the outcome of the individual participants/ teams performance in the Hackathon.

#### **Q17. Since there is no specific technology mentioned, are there any restrictions using pre-built libraries?**

There is no restriction to use any language, technology stack, or libraries **as long as they are publicly available and/or those offered on free trials**. Paid APIs are **NOT** allowed. You can use any tools (subject to the above pre-condition) at your disposal to create the solution / idea.

All Participants must start hacking/coding **fresh** during the Event. No one is allowed to pre-code anything or work on existing projects.

#### **Q18. How can I access the CTF server?**

You can only access the CTF server via Fortnynja's virtual private network (VPN).

Before the CTF challenge begins, we will release a set of files pertaining to your VPN access. These files are unique to each participants, and contain:

1. the instructions on how to set up the VPN on different operating systems, and
2. the VPN config file.

Please ensure that you allocate enough time to set up the VPN before the CTF challenge begins.

#### **Q19. Can I access the CTF server via multiple computers?**

No. Each participant will only receive one set of VPN config. Each VPN configuration only works for one active connection.



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#### **Q20. Where can I find the VPN config files?**

The config file and the instructions to set up the VPN will be available on FortNynja's platform prior to the CTF challenge.

On the FortNynja's platform, go to your profile > Qualifications. You should see a zip file titled "CTF config" under your qualifications.

Please contact us as soon as possible if you do not see the config file in your profile.

#### **Q21. Who owns the Intellectual Property (IP) rights to the solutions that are built?**

All Intellectual Property (IP) rights to the designs and codes of the app/prototype developed at this Hackathon are wholly owned by the Participant(s). It is the Participant's responsibility to ensure that the idea submitted is your original idea/work and/or does not infringe the intellectual property rights of any other individuals, organizations, and/or companies.

#### **Q22. Who do I reach out to if I have any questions on the platform?**



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
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### Q23. How can I submit a report?

#### Step 1: Browse “Invited Programmes”




#### Step 2: View a specific programme




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**Step 3: Click the 'Submit report' button**

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#### Q24. What should be included in the submission?

##### a) Capture the Flag (CTF) Challenge

Note: Each submission should only contain **ONE** flag. If you discover multiple flags, please submit separate reports.

**Name field** -> [team name]-[flag name]  
e.g. TeamBravo-wh@cKTh3Fort{14761478}

Note: Team Name should **NOT** contain any space.

**IMPORTANT:** All CTF submissions must adhere to this format. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.


##### Description

The participants have the freedom of selecting the platform to host the MVP [e.g. Vercel, Netlify, Heroku].



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#### Q25. What is the flow of the pitch for Build MVP track?

- a. Participants are required to pitch to a Panel of Judges on 9 April 2022 for Round 1, with the shortlisted teams invited to pitch for the Finals on 10 April.
- b. The sequence of the presentations will be randomly selected via <https://randomresult.com/>.
- c. There will be two (2) rounds of pitch. The First Round will include all teams that made a submission.
- d. At the end of the First Round pitch, the top five (5) teams shortlisted will submit their revised pitching deck and are required to pitch on the Final round.
- e. All pitches will be conducted via Zoom. Details will be provided on the Discord server.

#### Q26. What are the judging criteria for Capture the Flag (CTF) track?

- a. Each flag will carry different points according to its level of difficulty.
- b. For each flag, the top three (3) teams that successfully capture the flag in the least amount of time will be awarded points with the following bonus:
  - i. First team = 50%
  - ii. Second team = 30%
  - iii. Third team = 15%
  - iv. For example, if a flag is worth 10 points, the teams will be awarded with:
    - First team =  $10 + 10 \times 0.5 = 15$  pts
    - Second team =  $10 + 10 \times 0.3 = 13$  pts
    - Third team =  $10 + 10 \times 0.15 = 11.5$  pts
    - All other teams = 10 pts
- c. In the event of a tie (same score shared by more than one (1) team), the tie breaker will be the number of flags captured. This will be verified by the judges based on the reports submitted. If the number of flags fails to break the tie, the second tie breaker will be the highest scoring flag captured.

#### Q27. What are the judging criteria for Build MVP track?

- a. Originality (15%);
- b. Feasibility / Usefulness (30%);
- c. Execution (15%);
- d. Presentation (40%)

#### Q28. When will the results be announced?

The results will be announced on the last day of the Hackathon i.e. **10 April 2022 (Sunday)** and winners will be notified via livestream on Zoom and Facebook Live.

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#### **Q29. What are the prizes for the winners?**

For both Capture the Flag (CTF) and Build MVP:

- 1st Prize = RM 25,000
- 2nd Prize = RM 10,000
- 3rd Prize = RM 5,000
- Other prizes totaling RM 20,000

#### **Q30. What are the benefits of participating in the Hackathon?**

Participants will have the opportunity to network and meet up with mentors during the Hackathon network. At the same time, participants may also be invited into the Cybersecurity and tech community for future networking events and for career / future support and continuous learning journeys via Discord.

#### **Q31. Under what circumstances will my participation in the Hackathon be disqualified?**

Participants may be dismissed or refused entry to the competition under the grounds of any form of harassment, lack of respect to other participants / judges / mentors / support team, or other breaches of ground rules.
